



At-A-Glance

ABFM recognizes that family physicians may sometimes experience delays in pursuing their board certification goals. The Entry and ReEntry process was created to help physicians gain certification after delays of three years or more.

ABFM provides you with a personalized dashboard in the MyABFM Portfolio where you can access outstanding activities to complete your initial certification or re-entry process. The portfolio is also a great tool to track your progress for completing your initial requirements maintaining your certification over the your career.

■ Certification Entry Process

You have three calendar years following the year in which you complete residency training to pass the Family Medicine Certification Exam, earn 50 certification activity points, and obtain a medical license. After that, you will be required to complete the Certification Entry Process to take the exam and gain initial certification status prior to your 7-year board eligibility period expiring.

■ Certification Re-Entry Process

If your certification has been expired for more than three years, you are required to complete the Certification Re-Entry Process to take the exam and gain initial certification status.

Completion	Successful Completion of Family Medicine Certification Examination

Requirements must be completed within three calendar years.
